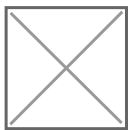
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Android Eduroam configuration

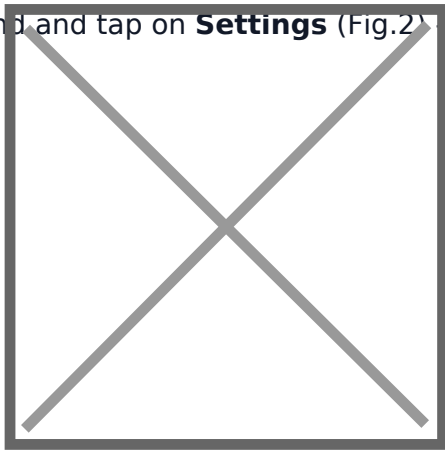
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Please note: Android devices vary and the process may look slightly different on your device.

1. From the home screen go to the Apps menu (Fig.1)

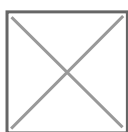


2. Find and tap on **Settings** (Fig.2) you may have to swipe several screens to the



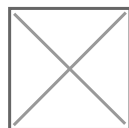
right to find it

3. In the Wireless & Networks section (Fig.3)



select **Wi-Fi**

4. The Wi-Fi screen will open and display a list of available networks

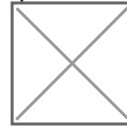


(Fig.4) Select **eduroam**

5. You will be prompted to sign in to the wireless network.

Enter the following details in the settings menu (Fig.5): **EAP method:** PEAP **Phase-2 authentication:** MSCHAPV2 **CA certificate:** Use system certificates **Domain:** <Your Domain> Example mycollege.ac.uk **Identity:** Your user ID appended with @domain for connecting to eduroam (e.g. ucxxzano @ mycollege.ac.uk **Anonymous identity:**

anonymous @ <domain> anonymous @ mycollege.ac.uk **Password:** your password



6. You should now be connected to the eduroam network (Fig.6)
